

# Marie Skłodowska-Curie Postdoctoral Fellowships (MSCA-PF)

Individual research stays for postdocs within and outside of Europe

Within “Horizon Europe”, the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Postdoctoral Fellowships support outstanding postdocs for conducting a “free choice” research project. The aim is enhance career development through international, interdisciplinary and intersectoral mobility that fosters knowledge exchange.

**The call has a submission deadline on 11 September 2024.**

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Postdoctoral Fellowships take the form of:

## European Fellowships (EF)

**Who can apply?** Researchers with a PhD and a maximum of 8 years of research experience.

**Mobility Rule?** Researchers may not have lived in Germany for more than 12 months in the last three years.

**Funding?** monthly salary and mobility allowances (researcher); research cost, travel cost, management and overhead (host).

**Duration?** 12 - 24 months with an optional additional placement in the non-academic sector.



## Global Fellowships (GF)

**Who can apply?** Researchers with a PhD and a maximum of 8 years of research experience. They must be nationals or long-term residents of an EU Member State or Associated Country.

**Mobility Rule?** Researchers must comply with the mobility rule (see EF) of the country of the “outgoing phase”, not for the country of the return phase.

**Funding?** monthly salary and mobility allowances (researcher); research cost, travel cost, management and overhead (host).

**Duration?** 24 - 36 months, consisting of a 12-24 months “outgoing phase” and a 12 months return phase to a the Medical Center – University of Freiburg with an optional additional placement in the non-academic sector.
